

DIP Seized 358 Counterfeit Goods at Chatuchak Weekend Market

From 2nd to 3rd March 2019, the DIP and the Metropolitan Police Bureau and the representative of foreign brand owners inspected different sections at Chatuchak Weekend Market. From the Inspection, the officers found an infringing activity and arrested a suspect. 358 counterfeit bracelets, belts, earrings, brooches, necklaces and rings that copied trademarks, including Louis Vuitton, Hermes, Chanel, Dior, Cartier and YSL were seized.

DIP and police officers have stationed at the Intellectual Property Enforcement Center (IPEC), Bang Sue Branch Police Station in Chatuchak Weekend Market area. Those who find any IPR infringing activities are encouraged to notify the officers promptly.
