

### Inspections in Chiangmai Areas

From 29<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>th</sup> January 2020, officers from The DIP, The Economic Crime Suppression Division, The Metropolitan Police Bureau jointly inspected Chiangmai province. Totally 346 counterfeit goods seizures, 7 activities and 3 arrests (Thais) were found as follows.

Chiangmai Night Bazaar Market, the officers found 4 infringing activities. 92 counterfeit goods such as eyeglasses, shirts, bags and pants that copied trademarks including Louis Vuitton, Gucci, Chanel, Prada, Hermes, Longchamp, Adidas, Nike, Tommy Hilfiger, Levi, Burberry, Polo, Lacoste, Ray-Ban, Oakley, Miu Miu and Dior were seized.

Rin Kam Market, the officers found 2 infringing activities and arrested 2 suspects. 25 counterfeit goods such as head bands, handkerchiefs, bags and cups that copied trademarks including Louis Vuitton, Dior, Gucci, Manchester United, Liverpool, Chelsea and Marc Jacobs were seized.

The Market, In front of Chiangmai - Kam Tiang Tesco Lotus Shopping Mall, the officers found an infringing activity and arrested a suspect. 229 counterfeit goods such as shirts and shoes that copied trademarks including Adidas and Nike were seized.
